Official Functions	 The Closing Function will be held at <u>Ainslie Football & Social Club</u> on Saturday 7 October 2023. Taking into consideration the feedback from last year, the following changes are confirmed for this year: Standalone venue (i.e. not sharing with any other functions). Indoor venue. Table service menu (i.e. no buffet menu). Dance floor provided. 						
Medical	Physio/osteopathy may be made available on a user-pays basis at the venue during competition hours. Hospitals and doctor's clinics are available within close proximity to the venue.						
Rules	The Event will be conducted in accordance with the TTA National Championships Regulations, the currer Laws of Table Tennis and ITTF Rules and Regulations.						
Clothing	Team Events: All athletes must wear their State/Territory Team uniform. NOTE: President's Team players must wear the designated President's Team shirt. Individual Events: Athletes may wear any clothing that complies with ITTF Regulations.						
Racket Control	All rackets must comply with ITTF Regulations. Racket control testing may be conducted.						
Motion and picture	Participants release all rights, or rights held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to televis and web casting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind TTA.						
Betting	In the context of betting, participants shall not, by any manner whatsoever infringe the principle of fair pl show unsporting conduct or attempt to influence the course or result of a competition or any part thereof a manner contrary to sporting ethics. Any violation of this principle shall be disciplined according to provisions of ITTF Regulations 3.5.3.						
Anti-Doping	All members, participants and non-participants are required to read and understand and agree to abide the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy, effective from 1 January 2021, and found on the Sport Integrit Australia website (<u>https://www.sportintegrity.gov.au/what-we-do/anti-doping/world-anti-doping-code/australian-nationalanti-doping-policy</u>), being the anti-doping policy adopted by TTA and applicable all members, participants and non-participants.
