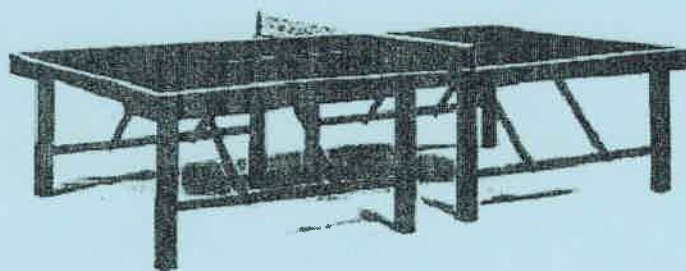

ADMINISTRATION OFFICER'S REPORT

Members, it gives me pleasure to present my ninth report as Administration Officer (part-time 3 days a week) for Table Tennis NSW Inc. The year 2004 was another busy and interesting one, which this report should indicate.

Tournaments

I am pleased that the members decided to continue to have a Director responsible for the conduct of tournaments. I have received many complementary reports from the members for the efficient and professional way Michael Turner and his assistants conducted them in 2004.

Where to play Table Tennis guide

This again has proved to be a valuable tool in the daily operation of the office. Over the course of a year I refer hundreds of inquires from the public as to where they can play Table Tennis to the nearest Club/Association. It is the duty of each Club/Association contact person to encourage all potential new members. Don't fall into the trap of feeling comfortable with current membership numbers of your club. There is a constant need to grow.

Outstanding Debts

It appears that debts continue as a result of non-payment of all fees associated with selection in NSW Teams at National Championships by some members. Directors may have to take a stronger stand against members who have not made full payment prior to participation at the Australian Championships or this trend will continue.

Equipment Sales

Since the hosting of a link to Combined Sports Traders on the Table Tennis NSW web-site sales of Table Tennis equipment through the office has almost ceased.

Registrations

Overall registration numbers have remained constant despite several new associations joining in 2004. Unfortunately some established Clubs/Associations recorded a negative result. This will have to be addressed by their Office Bearers.

Member should be mindful of one of the many benefit associated with a larger number of registered members is the financial burden will be smaller because it is shared by a larger number of people.

Every effort will have to be made in 2005 to convert social players into registered members.

Loop

Three editions of LOOP were distributed in March, August and December in 2004 and posted to members. Most of the articles have been placed on our Web site for the public to access. Once again I would like to thank all of the people who submitted articles for publication, they made interesting and informative reading. Thank you to our advertisers, I hope that you received value for money.

NSW Department of Tourism, Sport & Recreation Involvement

NSW Department of Tourism, Sport & Recreation continue to be our main source of income. With out which this Association could not continue to provide the many services it

does for its members and the sport in general. Table Tennis NSW received \$20,000.00 for 2004

Country Athlete Scheme applications continue to be negotiated directly with the Department and the parent. My only involvement apart from the distribution of the Application Forms is to verify membership currency and have the Junior Selectors prioritise the applicants. Five of our Junior Members were successful in 2004 sharing \$3,300.00.

The scheme to financially assist NSW Country Coaches and Officials was continued in 2004, \$560.00 was shared by two of our members.

Two of our Directors attended a "Risk Management Seminar" conducted by the Department during 2004. I attended a "Respect and Responsibility Seminar".

In addition to free access to the Internet and E-mail, NSW Department of Tourism, Sport & Recreation provide free office accommodation at Sports House and access to photo copying equipment. This is very much appreciated.

Assistance to Coaching Director

I was pleased to assist with 92 pieces of outgoing correspondence associated with the Coaching Director's portfolio. This was mainly due to reaccreditation of 16 NSW Coaches and the conduct of a Level 1 course attended by 22 prospective new level 1 coaches. This was in addition to the allocation of coaches to school sports programs.

Conclusion

I consider that the duties of Office Administrator are a very important link between the public, NSW Department of Tourism, Sport & Recreation, the Directors and the sport of Table Tennis.

SECRETARY'S REPORT – 2004

2004 was a very productive year for Table Tennis NSW.

We gained eight new affiliated associations/clubs –

- Table Tennis Group of the Chinese Youth League of Australia
- Sydney University of Sydney Table Tennis Club
- Mental Health Sports Association of NSW & ACT
- Gina's Training Centre
- Hurricane Table Tennis Club
- Metropolitan Leagues Indoor Sports Council
- Spears Sports Club
- Coffs Harbour Ex-Services Table Tennis Club

Table Tennis NSW also held a Level one coaching course presented by Joe Hoad from SA there were 24 participants and to date 14 have completed the course requirements and attained level one coaching status – NSW also had eight representatives attend a level 2 coaching seminar in Melbourne for a week, presented by Table Tennis Australia – very promising for the coaching ranks.

2004 was our 3rd year at Sydney Olympic Park – Sports Halls and again in good partnership with the State Sports Centre Trust

We look forward to re-introducing the TOPS program in 2005 – offering both Bronze & Silver – Tuesdays –

The venue was open Tuesdays from 7pm to 9 pm for training & coaching – Paul Zhao the on duty coach

On Thursday nights the Metropolitan / Insurance Competition has expanded even further – it is good to see more & more junior teams and players participating in one of the two grades. The competition also includes novice players & coaching. Congratulation to Les Walczuk for his continued organisation & success of this competition – this comp will recommence on Thursday 3rd February 2005.

The City Vs Country annual challenge was again a very enjoyable & successful day with City this year being victorious

In 2004 NSW had the venue for one national championships run by Table Tennis Australia:

- 1) Australian Athletes with Disabilities Championships – this was the 2nd annual championships held at the Olympic Park Sports Halls and ran over three days – a very successful championships conducted by Table Tennis Australia – with an enormous assistance from NSW volunteers – Kogarah RSL – Douglas Flood, Edd Nash & members as well as the NSW Disabilities Director – Beryl Davies & the Volunteers from the NSW Veterans Association.

The 2004 Tournaments took on a new look with the tournament director using a different computerised draw for all tournaments – the same which is used for National Veterans Championships - this still highlight a few problem areas, which will be rectified in 2005 – we have booked additional area (the middle zone) for Junior & Veterans – Open & Closed Tournaments as well as the Metropolitan Open, this will allow up to 28

tables for singles round robin matches. – It is essential that ALL players arrive on time for their scheduled matches and are ready to play when called on by the organisers.

The NSW Schools tournaments were also successful with the new Schools Director Andrew Roden having packed stadiums for most events. Andrew was well assisted by Tien Quach & Wendy Au. Tien organised an early closing date for each event which allowed draws to be timed and forwarded to each school in advance, this proved extremely successful. Andrew formed sub committees with the teachers, providing valuable feedback

Our representative teams for 2004 have once again had excellent performances.

2005 will be a very busy year – commencing with the:



While the older players move into the Youth and Senior's division, we had an influx of new young blood in the under 12 age groups, which is a necessity for the continuing growth of Junior Table Tennis in NSW.

Australian Junior Championships

The 2004 Australian Junior Championships was held in Perth. There were 39 juniors selected to represent New South Wales. There were 2 teams (A & B) for both Girls and Boys in each of the 3 age groups (under 14, under 16 and under 18), except the under 18 Women's team where there was only 1 NSW team.

I would like to congratulate all players for their efforts throughout the Championships.

The NSW A Team players achieved outstanding results, winning medals and achieving top 10 rankings. The B (development) Team players competed exceptionally well, lifting their level of play well above their limits. The experience gained will definitely build up their strength and benefit them in 2005.

NSW players improved in all areas – teams, individual and national rankings.

Achievements were:

- winning medals in 5 out of the 6 teams events
- 11 players won medals in individual events
- 11 NSW players were ranked in the top 10 at the conclusion of the Championships.

Table Tennis Australia Athletes with a Disability Connect Program

I attended a seminar in Brisbane for the Disability Action Plan for 2004-2006. The only states that did not attend were Tasmania and Northern Territory. Follow up meeting to this program will be held in Canberra March 2005. Our mission in 2005 is to gather data of the development of each athlete acknowledging the reality that there remains unfilled needs and challenges.

Planning for the future of our Disabled Athletes

I attended a Sport Ability Program developed by the Australian Sports Commission at Revesby for Polybat. Polybat is suitable for players who have arm, balance or coordination impairments who can grasp a bat but would find Table Tennis difficult. They may in the future advance to Table Tennis. This will be played in the south west of Sydney then advance to other areas. Equipment and resources will be provided free of charge to participating schools. The program will also meet initial trainer training. Follow up meeting to this program will be held in Canberra in March 2005.
