

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen.

I present my President's Report for the calendar year of 1996. I am extremely proud of the range of activities TTNSW has been engaged in over this period. I believe that TTNSW must now rank as one of the most pro-active State Associations in Australia. This is a considerable achievement in the face of our three main problems: the lack of State officials, infrastructure and playing headquarters. The good news is that these problems are gradually being rectified and I am confident that we are emerging from the bad years of stagnancy and decline.

Early in the year we appointed Ron Pickering to the part time position of Administration Officer. Ron has now settled in and is doing a great job with his office duties while assisting the Board with putting new systems and procedures in place. He has produced invaluable new resources for members including the Junior Guide, list of playing venues and the TTNSW marketing catalogue. In a nutshell, Ron's role revolves around membership services and I am sure in the future he will prove to be a valuable asset to this Association.

The Board/Council has also been active in the area of administration. We have changed the size of the Council (form 13 to 7 Directors), implemented the Acord Membership system, acquired a new computer and printer, worked on a new logo, established Conditions of Affiliation and employed an Administration Officer. In addition of course were the many administration issues that arise from time to time which the Board/Council had to deal with. I am happy to say that the Board, who is responsible for Administration, worked cooperatively and effectively in resolving many difficult problems. My thanks to Doug Flood, Phil Males and Norma Callinan for their work and attendance at meetings.

The biggest highlight of the year undoubtebly was the successful conduct of the Australian Junior Championships at the E.G. Whitlam Centre, Liverpool. My sincerest gratitude to the hard working Organising Committee. I would like to give Noel Shorter, Beryl Davies, Phil Males, Warren Gray, Steven Lee, Ghiath Khalil and Doug Flood a special mention. With this committed group under Noel's guidance, we showed the rest of Australia what NSW was capable of. For many of us it was a learning experience and I know we look forward to hosting another National event in the not too distant future.

The NSW Department of Sport and Recreation provided invaluable support to TTNSW in 1996. After several meetings with the Sports Management Advisory Service, Bryan Spencer presented TTNSW with a Strategic Plan which we are now gradually implementing. We also had a record amount of recipients receiving Country Athlete Grants. The Department of Sport continues to be our major sponsor and supports TTNSW in a variety of ways. We extend our sincerest appreciation to the staff at Sports House for all their help in 1996.

Tournaments this year were reasonably successful. A new Tournament Committee of Derek Kerr, Steven Lee and Tony Lee did their best to bring quality events to our members. The highlights were the Junior Open and Closed with record entries in each event, and the Metropolitan open with 150+ entries. On the down side, more work needs to be done on the presentation and overall organisation of our Tournaments. It is imperative that we get a proper grading and seeding system in place. The good news is that now have now upgraded all our tables, score counters and score tables so this is a step in the right direction. A special thank you to Derek Kerr who is retiring from the Council in 1997. After many years of service toTTNSW, Derek is taking a break so he can concentrate on winning a few Over 50's events

Congratulations to our Volunteer of the Year, Gillian Hutchinson. This year, Gillian was the driving force behind our inaugural TTNSW Women's Team event. Gillian has also been actively involved in Women's issues in Sport on behalf of Table Tennis, and has attended several forums and meetings. The Secondary and Primary Schools Team Events are now firmly established and continue to grow under Gillian's guidance. Our thanks to her and her assistants for conducting these crucial events.

On the matter of Schools, our Primary and Secondary Individual Schools Championships held in December were well attended. Around 200 players entered with strong interest being expressed form many new players who want to get more involved with Table Tennis. Schools from NSW dominated the National Schools Championships for a second year in a row. It is our aim to provide regular grade competitions for all juniors in 1997. At the time of writing, preparations for this new competition were well underway. Both the Team and Individual Schools Events provide us with recruitment oppurtunities which must be followed up. It is part of our plan to employ a Development Officer in 1997 to establish Clubs for children to learn and play in. We now need to get volunteer coaches, parents and managers on board to be part of this major initiative.

In the National arena, Stella Zhou won her first National singles title at the Australian Closed Championships and assisted our Women's team in their victory at the National Teams Championships. Guy Fainblum, Daniel Urbina and Jason Abacan also won medals in the Youth Doubles. Charles Chau is the first NSW junior to be ranked nationally for the first time in several years. A rundown of the numerous achievements of the veterans appear later in the Annual Report. Congratulations to all teams and individuals who performed admirably in 1996.

A variety of other activities and achievements included the Junior Boys Top 10, the beginning of the TTNSW Administration Manual, the highest number of coaches in Australia, research into the possibility of an academy and a constantly improving LOOP (thank you Ghiath). Our financial situation has gone from a deficit to surplus and we have changed our accounting methods in accordance with government recommendations. More details on finance are covered later in the Annual Report. My thanks to Phil once again for all his work in this most important area.

1996 was the year in which both Keith Bowler and Norma Callinan retired from TTNSW. How can I sum up in a paragraph two voluntary careers that almost span a century between them? Their contribution to Table Tennis in this State has been invaluable. Both are deserved Life Members of TTNSW and TTA which is recognition of their services to our sport. Keith extended his role to the International arena which last year rewarded his efforts with the equivalent of a life membership of the ITTF. Norma represented NSW as a player and for many years was our Delegate to Table Tennis Australia. May I thank you both for your encouragement and advice and wish you a happy and healthy retirement.

I conclude my report by re-affirming my own commitment to the wonderful organisation known as TTNSW. I am totally dedicated to transforming our Association into the major sport it deserves to be. Our volunteers and staff are shaping a great future for a great sport in a State that has such enormous potential. Despite all the criticisms, the fact is that TTNSW is getting on with the job of promoting and controlling our sport. It is a rewarding experience to be involved with such a dynamic organisation and I cannot understand why more people do not want to hop on board and be part of the success. To everyone who has assisted throughout the year, my sincerest thanks. There may be a few bumps in the road that lies ahead, but the fact that we are now on the road means that we are starting to head somewhere.

ADMINISTRATION OFFICER'S REPORT.

A tremendous amount has been achieved since my part time employment commenced on 1 May 1996, highlights of which can be found in this report.

General

I have been heavily involved with a number of projects including :-

- The most significant undertaking was the setting up a data base of where to play Table Tennis. This has proved to be a most valuable asset and is referred to countless times each day. The list has grown to 62 venues.
- NSW Primary & Secondary School Students Championship. A comprehensive data base was set up prior to this impressive tournament. All relevant player details are now kept on file for future use. Already this information has been put to use with each Affiliated Association receiving a list of players who live in their area, so that they may be included in their 1997 coaching programs.
- STIGA 1996 Australian Junior Championships, pre, during and subsequent.
- Designing, copying and distributing tournament entry forms.
- Assisting Australian Taxation Office staff in the preliminary planning of their National Championships. Which will be played at the Leichhardt Table Tennis facility, thus bringing in additional income for Table Tennis NSW.
- Helping out with the production of LOOP has been another major part of my responsibilities. So far I have written 18 articles and designed advertisements for products that we at Table Tennis NSW can pass on to our members.
- Helped design a promotional pamphlet "Junior Guide Where to play Table Tennis / How to play Table Tennis".
- Preparing an Association & Individual Member Affiliation Package.

Department Of Sport And Recreation

- I have developed a good working relation with Departmental staff.
- Distributing, Submitting and notifying successful Country Athletes Grant applications
- Arranged for a number of promotional pamphlets and registration forms to be included on The Department of Sport and Recreation booth at the February Sports Expo at Darling Harbour.

Publicity

- Attended a one day Sport and the Media seminar, conducted by Dept. Of Sport And Recreation. From this I have produced a "How to work with the Media guide", which can be used when trying to gain publicity for Table Tennis in the future.
- A large number of Press Releases have been prepared and forwarded to various Media outlets covering NSW Junior Open, STIGA Australian Junior Open, NSW Veterans Open, Best of the Best and NSW Primary and Secondary School Students Championship.
- Posters have been produced and forwarded to various Youth and PCYC throughout the State promoting some of our events.

Sponsorship

- Sponsorship has been successfully gained from The Emperors Choice Chinese Restaurant (1996 State Closed Championship).
- Best Western Motels providing discounts for registered NSW members.
- Sponsorship in the form of advertisements for LOOP has been gained from AAA Table Tennis Imports (Equipment) to cover three issues, and Johns & Mascall (Legends of Table Tennis Video) for one issue.

Conclusion

I am pleased with my efforts so far and the way things are developing. I also realise that a lot more has to be done, the only restriction appears to be time. The feedback I have received from both the members and the general public indicates that my job is an essential service and I am encouraged by the gratitude expressed by those I have been able to assist.

I would like to thank past Committee members for their valuable help and look forward to working with an enthusiastic new Committee in 1997. Together taking Table Tennis to greater levels of professionalism.

REPORT

Ladies & Gentlemen, I present the financial report for Table Tennis NSW Inc for the financial year 1 January 1996 to 31 December 1996.

I am pleased to advise that a surplus of \$2967-57 was achieved which was mainly due to transfer of government grants monies left over from the 1995 year being finalised in 1996. In addition we were able to consolidate grant monies for 1996 and transfer of the majority of these was also effected. As you can see from the report, some of these are still unexpended for 1996 but council have steps in hand to clear these as soon as possible.

It has been a difficult year and I don't think we are completely over our financial problems at this stage. Without the government funding we would not have been able to operate at all and on behalf of the association I thank the NSW Department of Sport and Recreation for their assistance both in monetary and in other areas over the year.

This report has been carefully complied from our records and audited by Certified Practising Accountants. We have taken plenty of time over this to get it right. A detailed stocktake of all equipment, both Table Tennis and office, was undertaken to find out exactly what we have. This is shown in the report. Even with care being taken, items were missed, but we are aware of them now and they will be adjusted this year.

In 1997 we must watch our finances carefully. The levy charged by Table Tennis Australia will be a problem to pay but this matter is still being addressed by Board of TTA and hopefully relief of some sort may come during the year. At least we hope so as I feel that if registrations do not increase this year we will have trouble to pay this levy.

With the new incentives introduced by TTNSW and TTA in regard to insurance being instigated this year, we hope this will increase affiliation of associations and club, and inturn will increase registrations. With cover provided in all aspects from Public Liability, through to player insurance, all persons involved in our sport are covered in one form or another.

I consider we should go into this year and consolidate what we have. With the office now running efficiently under Ron Pickering and with the impending appointment of a Development Officer, we hope everything is looking up. Plans are also in place to appoint a reliable tournament committee and in 1997 we want NSW run tournaments to get back to what they were a few years ago, something you are proud to play in and support.

I trust everyone will give their support and time to make Table Tennis in NSW great again.

COACHING REPORT

I present this report of Coaching activities for the period January to December 1996.

A number of coaching and development activities were planed and conducted throughout the year.

The funding from the Department of Sport and Recreation for the salary subsidy was redirected from Coaching Director to a General Development fund that provided funds for specific programs - Coach Education, School Promotion and State Development Squad Training. The purpose for this decision was to assist in the planing of programs that would promote the sport and hopefully increase the number of participants involved in Table Tennis activities. This has proven successful in certain areas, however the increase in the numbers of players registered with Affiliated Associations has been somewhat disappointing. I believe the challenge facing TTNSW is to positively influence and assist associations to streamline their affairs to enable the provision of a quality service to new, as well as existing members. concur with the sentiments expressed in the Presidents Report regarding the provisions of regular competition for players at all levels, from beginner to elite.

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

The Schools program commenced in early 1996 in the Campbelltown area as a Table Tennis Australia initiative was continued throughout the year and five schools visited. These visits have led to a steady flow of players on to the local Campbelltown Junior PCYC which operates as one of the most successful clubs in Sydney, operating with a sound management base and qualified coaching staff. Special thanks to Jim Wright and Michael Pilottos for their assistance in these promotions in both the schools and club operations.

A number of schools sought coaching for development purposes and/or to prepare schools for representative duty at State and National level. The appointment of a Coaching/Development Officer in 1997 should ensure a more pro-active approach to the development of Table Tennis in the school setting.

NATIONAL COACHING COMMITTEE

As the NSW representative on the NCC, I continued a close association with the National Coach Mr Zhou Lan Sun, the National Coaching Director Mr Glen Tepper and the National Development Officer Miss Wilhemina Pruyen. Issues relating to Coach Education and National training camps as well as the National Schools Championships required regular attention. The National Junior Training Camp in Sydney in July was also a great success under the guidence of Glen Tepper ,Alois Rosario andf myself.

COACH EDUCATION

Although no regional National Coaching Accreditation Scheme Level 1 Courses were conducted over the past year, sufficient demand has led to the planing of a Level 1 Course at Campbelltown on the 8/9 March. Interest has been very strong with up to half of the sixteen participants being from country areas.

A Level 1 course was conducted at the University of Western Sydney with ten students gaining Level 1 NCAS Accreditation.

A proposed Level 11 Course has been deferred whilst the new National Coach Mr Jerzy Grycan re-accesses course content and his schedule of visits to states. Three coaches have successfully completed the Level 11 Principles of Coaching Course conducted by the Department of Sport and Recreation and should qualify at this level during 1997.

The process of re-accreditation for all NCAS coaches in 1996 was a drawn out affair that caused a number of telling problems. Eventually after most coaches responded to the requirements, the National Register saw the following statistics related to NSW,

Level 111 3 Level 11 3 Level 1 42

Which at the time was the highest of all the states. Hopefully programs can be developed to allow opportunities for coaches to impact positively on the training of players.

SQUAD TRAINING

Sessions were conducted for each of the representative teams. Seniors, Juniors, Veterans and Sub-Junior as part of the Athlete Development. Sessions were held at Fort Street High School and Greenacre YMCA. Special thanks to Johnny Zhou, Tony Lee, Eric Carswell and Frank Pettigrove for their efforts with squad training.

OLYMPIC ATHLETE PROGRAM

Two NSW athletes Stella Zhou and Genna Raber were members of the OAP. Genna performed credibly in the Olympic play-offs but could not force his way into the team, losing narrowly in crucial matches. Congratulations to Stella on becoming National Singles and Doubles Champion and an Olympian during 1996. Katherine Ying Kwok also participated in the Olympic play-offs and despite an intensive training program leading up to the event was unsuccessful in her bid to qualify for her second Olympics.

DEVELOPMENT

Over the past two months a Development Management Plan has been researched and compiled. The plan will be presented to Club Associations, Coaches and School Teachers at an open forum on March 23 1997. The plan which is in draft format needs to be endorsed by the operators for ratification by the Board of TTNSW. The key performance areas of the plan are Increased Participation, Club Development, Schools Promotion and Management.

Special thanks to Danielle Chan for her assistance in the compilation of the plan.

CONCLUDING REMARKS

I wish to express my appreciation to all the people who have assisted in the area of coaching during 1996 at State, Regional and Club level, often without the glamour attached to coaching "champions". A new breed of coaches are emerging and I consider it essential that they have the opportunity to assist players develop. For this they also require positive role models. Hopefully new Development programs will present new challenges to all coaches leading up to Sydney 2000. I congratulate all players who were successful in National Championships in both Individual and Teams play, especially those who were medallists. Finally a thank you to the Council on TTNSW for their continued efforts to lift the image and profile of Table Tennis.
