## Cleaning and Sanitising Schedule - Managing unwell participants

- 1) Venue will ensure all hard surfaces are appropriately cleaned and sanitised prior to set-up
- 2) All tables , chairs and equipment including balls will be cleaned firstly with DETTOL wipes at set-up
- 3) All tables , chairs and equipment including balls will be sanitised with 75% alcohol wipes at set-up
- 4) During break ie lunchtime or after round robin events the same will apply a clean followed by sanitising
- 5) After play has been completed the same process a clean followed by sanitising
- 6) To ensure absolute safety no FLIP OVERs will be used (hearing impaired members- excepted in this case the same cleaning and sanitising procedures will be in place)
- 7) Another safety precaution players are requested to bring their own pen you will be asked on arrival whether you have a pen you will be issued a pen if you do not. NO pen sharing
- 8) Strick controls on finishing times at least 30 minutes are required to clean and sanitise equipment
- 9) 3 x allocations of balls to allow cleaning and sanitising during the break
- 10) Follow the "Help keep COVID away " hygiene notice

## An isolation area has been identified -please follow the below procedure if required

- a) On entry your temperature will be taken –if your temperature is 38 degrees you will be advised and you may re-test in 30 minutes if you fail the 2<sup>nd</sup> test you will be denied entry and should seek medical attention have a COVID test see your GP and if required self-isolate
- b) You will be required to answer the questions on the COVID declaration form if you answer <u>NO</u> to any of the questions you will be denied entry and should seek medical attention have a COVID test see your local GP and if required self-isolate
- c) Condition of return either for: a or b will be a clearance from NSW Health Authorities
- d) It is heavily recommended that you download the COVID Safe app
- e) If you develop symptoms after entry please advise a COVID Marshall <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> identified by a yellow Hi Viz vest
- f) You will be advised to proceed to the isolation area with your belongings and will be issued a <u>BIO MASK</u> and gloves you will be assessed by either a first aid or medical person who will have access to a full coverall suit and a medical ISO visor
- g) The venue will complete the appropriate notification protocols for notifying public health authorities
- h) If the unwell person is identified by a health official as COVID positive
- Table Tennis will then be required to advise anyone in close contact and ALL matches will cease
  IMMEDIATELY and all players are to have a COVID test and self-isolate
- j) We will hand our registers and any required paperwork to the Health Authorities
- k) The venue will be required to have a FULL clean and sanitise by the approved authorities
- I) The Health Authorities will do a <u>FULL audit</u> on our procedures in place.
- m) Please remember if you have any medical condition please report it **IMMEDIATELY** so appropriate and prompt action can ensue
