

NSW Junior State Team Selection Criteria 2016

In 2016 the Australian Junior Closed Championships will be held in Alice Springs from :

2nd July to 9th July inclusive – the Junior selection criteria will be :

Compulsory: Both Tournaments:

NSW Junior Closed Championships - Sunday 6th March 2016 at HALC - Venue & date to be confirmed

NSW Junior Open Championships - Sunday 17th April 2016 At HALC - Venue and date to be confirmed

Compulsory Selection Round Robins : (Sydney based players only)

All players in each squad will be required to attend the compulsory round robins on the first night: ie: $U13's - 10^{th}$ February $- U15's - 17^{th}$ February & $U18's - 23^{rd}$ February any unfinished matches will be played on the Saturday 23^{rd} April

Immediately after the NSW Junior Open the NSW selectors will select all A team players. 4 Players maximum per team.

Players who wish to qualify for a NSW B team spot and a President's team nomination (2 players maximum) will need to qualify for the position in the round robin playoffs on Saturday 23rd April at Sports Halls Sydney Olympic Park starting at 10 am

Only the top 10 players according to Rating Central will be eligible for the qualification for B team play offs in each age division.

The 10 players nominated will be split in two groups of 5 players each. All players will play each other a best of 5 match. The first player in each group will automatically qualify for a B team spot. The second player in group will verse the third player of the other group and the winner will qualify for a B team spot. The two loser players will be nominated for a president's team. ie: the top three positioned players in each group will be selected for either the B team or a Presidents team nomination.

Compulsory Team training: Sydney based players to attend Tuesdays & Saturdays – Country players Saturdays
