MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT:

Over the years, this Association has been subjected to much criticism, most of which being non-constructive, petty in nature and made by persons who have not been fully aware of the facts relative to the subject of their criticism.

However, if the Association can be criticised, then you should also share in this criticism because, as a member of the Association, you by your attendance, or non-attendance, at an Annual General Meeting, directly or indirectly, elect the people responsible for the conducting of the game in this State.

I am often at a loss as to what motivates some members to consider standing for Council in the first place, as at year's end, we usually find that the everyday running of the Association has fallen into the laps of the faithful few, who have devoted many years of hard work and received as a reward small satisfaction in seeing our sport growing ever so slowly.

It would seem to me that some people are nominated to fill a position on Council principally to defeat a sitting member, or to prevent a new member being elected. This action is part of our democratic heritage. However, it would be nothing short of hypocrisy if that person, having been elected, did not do his or her fair share of work motivated by the thought of assisting table tennis as a whole, and not any one group or individual.

Attendance of members at Council meetings this year has been poor to say the least and at this point of time, I would like to thank the few affiliated associations who send a delegate to represent them at our monthly meetings. On many occasions, if it were not for these delegates, meetings would not be able to proceed due to a lack of a quorum.

In the concluding paragraph of my report last year, I stated:

"I can only hope that the petty jealousies, vindictiveness, apathy, self-interest and parochial attitudes I have become aware of will cease and there will be a coming together of individuals, organisations and affiliated associations for the general good of the sport in this State". Although in many instances, opposing factions of previous years have worked together a little more harmoniously, we still have to contend with personality clashes being allowed to dictate the whims and actions of members. The incoming Council must remember that they have been elected to perform various tasks and that the game must be put ahead of their personal feelings towards one another on all matters involving table tennis.

No Council can fulfil its duties successfully if there is bickering, back-biting and a lack of willingness to work with one another, nor can they achieve their goals without the support of the general members.

In closing, I wish to thank I.T.T. Pty. Ltd. for their assistance in helping us stage the Singapore Airlines Table Tennis Classic and the Australian Broadcasting Commission for televising this event. Also, I wish to thank A.P.D. Snack Foods Pty. Ltd. for once again sponsoring the Samboy Under 15 years Championship and all those who assisted in the staging of this event throughout New South Wales. My special thanks to Armstrong Co. Ltd. for their assistance in providing the services of Japanese Coach, Mr. Muneharu Yasu, and the N.S.W. Police Citizens Boys Clubs for their valuable assistance throughout the year. Special thanks are due to our hard-working secretary, Mrs. Maureen King, Mr. Fred Richardson for his efforts in keeping our books, Mrs. Joy Brown for her dedicated work as Coaching Co-ordinator and Miss Carol Hughes for her excellent work in tournament administration and to the working members of the Council.

COACHING REPORT FOR 1979.

The year just ended showed yet further development in the National Coaching Scheme. The Acton Awards scheme was born where players can obtain gold, silver or bronze awards by passing a set examination. Delegates attended a National Coaching seminar in Adelaide where lecturers spoke on psychology motivation, and physiology of coaching as well as the need for courses that can be undertaken through universities to improve ones coaching ability. I also attended an Australian wide Sports forum at Sydney University to find out whats needed to improve sport in Australia. Aspects discussed included, development programme for schools, sports lottery, separate ministry for Sport, Australian games and promotion of sports. A Tour was undertaken late in the year by Japanese Coach Munehard Yasu. Although the N.S.W. section of the tour was wrecked to a certain degree by his late arrival in Australia all players who were lucky enough to receive coaching were very impressed by Munehara. Hopefully he will be spending more time in N.S.W. before his return to Japan. Sixteen new coaches attained their awards throughout the year and four were upgraded to state and area coaches. Unfortunately, those people obtaining awards do not put their awards into action and it is still left to a devoted few to provide most of the coaching throughout the state. Congratulations to those who have discovered the rewards of coaching and I'm hoping many more will show the interest needed to bring N.S.W. back to the best.
