PRESIDENT'S REPORT

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,

The most notable achievement of the past year was the appointment of a fully employed coach/administrator for the State of New South Wales. Eric Coster, who had previously fulfilled this role in Ireland was selected, from in excess of thirty applicants, for this position. He arrived in October and so far has spent many hours and weeks in coaching and assisting in the administration of table tennis within various sporting organisations and Country areas. I am sure that the benefits of Eric's ability and experience will be most evident to you throughout the year, 1975.

On the playing side I am pleased to say that our sub-juniors were responsible for outstanding performances at their Australian Championships earlier this year. New South Wales emerged as the most successful State in these grades and it was certainly a fine effort from all the players and officials involved. Our performances however in the Senior ranks were again most disappointing and it will be some time before we can expect to be a serious challenger to the Champion State, Victoria.

A notable introduction was the N.S.W. Closed Championships which were held in Canberra. There were record entries in this event and all matches were keenly contested. It is intended that this championship be held each year in a country area where I believe we will gain the utmost benefit for this type of promotion.

May I finally take this opportunity of thanking all officials, and players of our affiliated associations for their co-operation during 1974.

The thirty-ninth Annual Report, to be presented to Members at the Annual General Meeting, to be held at the A.M.P. Society, on 26th February, 1975.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,

This, the thirty-ninth Annual Report covers the activities of your Association, for the year 1974.

The Association again had a busy year which was highlighted by the visit to Australia of the very highly rated Czechoslovakian team which included such players as Milan Orlovski, current European Champion and ranked No. 3 in the world, Jaroslav Kunz who has had wins over some of the top players in the world, also Alicia Grofova who was runner up in the Women's Singles Final at the last Worlds Championships.

The Czechs played matches at various country areas throughout the State i.e. Tamworth, Canberra and also an International Tournament at Bankstown Town Hall. They were successful in all these matches. In fact they only lost one match during their whole tour of Australia. The Final Test Match in Perth.

The Association also took a major step forward towards improving table tennis in this great State by the appointment of a top flight English coach Eric Coster, who already has made his presence felt during his short stay with us. Welcome to New South Wales, Eric.

Also a new concept took effect by the staging of our State Titles and other championships, including all grades at various centres throughout the metropolitan area, i.e. City of Sydney Police Boys Club, Sutherland etc. and proved to be a great success. This event was an idea of Mike Lane who took it upon himself to run these championships. Well done, Mike.

Men's Doubles. In this event we had a success with Paul Pinkewich sharing the title with Bob Tuckett.

Junior Boys. This event was won by Philip Gebauer beating Robbie Javor, Victoria in the Final.

AUSTRALIAN SUB JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:

These events were held in Mackay during May 1974. New South Wales was responsible for a great Junior Carnival winning the Under 16 Boys Teams, Under 14 Boys and Girls Teams.
