

PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2006

To all concerned,

My first year as President has been a challenging with constant flow of information, new tasks to get involved with, getting to know city and country players and officials as well as dealing with TTA and Project Connect delegates. The NSW Board Members have provided great assistance, not only to me, but also the table tennis players and associations, without them my task would be daunting, thank you all.

The rewards have been few and more work needs to be done. Our table tennis player numbers are steadily growing with this year a small increase of sixty eight new players of which twelve were registered as athletes with disabilities. The number of affiliated Associations remain the same, however, it is noted that Central Coast T.T. Assn. have joined for the first time.

One of my goals is to appoint a permanent director to focus at player numbers and Associations to build up our base and promote TTNSW to the general public. This person will also be dedicated to develop and maintain a data base to enable verification of player contact details, which currently has not reached a satisfactory standard. At the 2007 AGM, I feel this position will be officially filled.

Another goal is the setting up of AWD events to encourage and develop a base of players that currently is not being sufficiently addressed. Currently there are many activities occurring behind the scene which is managed by Beryl Davies and her volunteers. See AWD directors report, it will enlighten. Please note that TTNSW needs more helpers to encourage growth in this area and also bring joy and self confidence to disadvantaged people which number in the thousands. Keep up the good work Beryl.

Our Administration Office for the past two years has gone through many staff changes and only recently moved to Homebush. This integral infrastructure of TTNSW is being managed by two staff on a part time bases and back up provided by the effervescent secretary Leonie Whiteford. Thanks to all concerned for your efforts, however, this situation can no longer continue due to a demanding schedule of commitments. We are certain that before the 2007 AGM the Administration role will be administered by one dedicated person on a four days a week service.

Our financial report shows that our financial situation is improving, however, new cost have occurred this year (2006) due to need to purchase more State shirts and tracksuits for our representative players. Phil Males, for several years has maintained a standard reconciliation which has been evolving to allow more transparency in our earnings and expenses so that we can examine areas that may need special attention. Thanks Phil and trust your service will continue.

We are focused in chasing various departments of the local and State Government for grants to finance all our activities. Dennis O'Brien volunteered his service in 2006. We hope to resource in the near future a team of people to be dedicated in not only increasing our cash flow but also provide creative ideas and initiatives, that will enhance our standing in the community.

I take this opportunity to give a special thank you to several volunteers that give up their time (which could run into several hours) to assist in the running of championship events, they are Tien Quach, Ian Finlay and Leonie Whiteford, Also for the AWD events they are John Younie, Sandra and Ronald Lynch. If I have failed to mention names of other volunteers please accept my gratitude for your service.

I am confident that in 2007, TTNSW will continue to improve service to members via the goals as detailed above.

In closing, I would like to thank our major sponsors NSW Department of Sport Tourism and Recreation and STIGA through Combined Sports Traders for their ongoing support through out 2006.

We have held a level one coaching course, which was presented by Sue Stevenson on 18th & 19th November at Fairfield PCYC and this was endorsed by NSW Department of Sport Recreation & Tourism who approved our application for a Women's Development grant – we plan to conduct regional level 1 training courses in early 2007.

New South Wales has also been heavily involved in the Sydney World Masters Games preparation for 2009. The New South Wales State Government was successful in the bid attempt to host these games. With 30,000 athletes from 100 nations across 28 sports of which Table Tennis is one – the dates for these games are $10th - 17^{th}$ October 2009. We have been negotiating with the Australian Veterans Committee to have the Australian Veterans Championships coincide with these Games for Sydney in 2009.

The Australian Veterans Championships this year attracted record numbers with – 88 teams and 309 entrants – so we are expecting record numbers – for more information on the World Masters Games please check the Website – www.2009worldmastersgames.com New South Wales is also about to enter stage 2 of project connect (Athletes with Disabilities) to

promote and provide more opportunities for these players and look forward to challenge matches with other AWD associations.

2006 Junior Director's Report

2006 proved to be a very busy year for out top junior players. They had the Australian Youth Championships (April), the Australian Top10 Cadet Challenge (April), the Oceania Championships (June) and the Australian Junior Championships (October).

Five of our top juniors, Kane Townsend(14), Belinda Le(15), Wade Townsend(16), Christopher Kwok(17) and Xiao Wang(17) were selected to represent NSW at the Australian Youth Championships.

NSW had 4 junior player (Kane, Belinda, Madeline Wong and Callain Howarth) qualifying for the Australian Top10 Cadet Challenge.

Kane, Belinda and Wade were selected in the Australian Junior Team for the Oceania Championships. In the team's event, they all gained valuable international competition experience playing against the best juniors from other country in the Oceania region.

In the individual event: Kane Townsend won Bronze (u15 Boy's Singles) and Gold (u15 Boys Doubles), Belinda Le won Silver (u15 Girls Singles) and Gold (u15 Girls Doubles) and Wade won Bronze (u18 Boys Singles & u18 Boys Doubles).

Our junior team proved to be a strong contender at the Australian Open when our debutants u14 year boys, Nathan Thai and Vincent Tran cause major upsets during the team's events.

In the individual events, they unite to win the Bronze for the u14 Boy's Doubles, upsetting the 4th seeded Victorian team along the way.

The only problems this year have been the occasional computer glitch but when this has happened the tournament still proceeds smoothly due to using a combination of computer and paper to run the tournaments.

I am looking forward to a very good 2007. If the start of this year is any indication then table tennis in NSW has a very bright future.

Disability Director's Report - 2006

As director of table tennis NSW disabilities I take this opportunity to wish you all joy and prosperity in the year 2007. Thank you to the volunteers who have supported and contributed to our success in 2006. I hope you continue to support athletes with a disability.

Table Tennis Australia conducted the Australian athletes with disabilities championships in Adelaide 2006. Congratulations to all athletes who represented NSW. I wish you all continued success in the year 2007.

Unfortunately due to diminished funding from Mental Health we are now unable to use the Addison Rd Centre Marrickville on a weekly basis. However, we did conduct a tournament followed by a sausage sizzle at the YMCA Greenacre and hope to run another tournament in March or April again at Greenacre.

Juniors:

Over the past year the boys and girls from Liverpool whom I have being closely working with have come along in leaps and bounds. I have recently started with a group from Bankstown. The outcome at this stage looks positive.

Pilot Program Undertaken:

Metropolitan team Pennant commenced the 7th of March 2006. Matches consisted of two singles and one doubles. The main aim of this competition was to socialize and have fun. Calendar updated to include athletes with a disability events at local, state and national tournaments.

Challenge Round for Athletes with a Disability at Albury Wodonga, NSW vs. VIC. This had to be cancelled due to a lack of support from Victoria. The format was for disabled participants, to be a mixture of wheelchair, amputees, as well as standing disabled and deaf players. Ages ranged from 19 – 60 plus. A lot of planning was put into this by Table Tennis New South Wales. We are confident this event will run again in 2007.

The Sydney Paralympic Talent Search held at the Catholic University Strathfield, Beaton Park Wollongong, NSW Institute of Sport Sydney Olympic Park, Wagga Wagga and Woy Woy, of which Table Tennis New South Wales was represented as a talent spotter. We picked up some young talent and are currently working with them.

In conjunction with Ausrapit and New South Wales Association of Disability Sport conducted a meeting to discuss sport and recreation opportunities for people with an intellectual disability in NSW. Pathways for local and international competition. This meeting was conducted on the 2/11/06 by Robyn Smith, Chief Executive Officer of Ausrapit Inc. We await a positive outcome.

National Plan for Athletes with a disability workshop conducted by the Australian Sports Commission. Provisions and opportunities for people with disabilities to participate in sport at all levels. During the process the ASC received over 140 submissions and about 255 people attended workshops nationwide. The reference group concluded its work in September 2006. In August 2006 the Australian Paralympic Committee established a taskforce to evaluate the current structures, pathways and programs in paralymic sport within Australia. The general consensus of the meeting was to contribute money to the grass roots of disabled sport. The taskforce report was concluded in August 2006. The National Plan for Paralymic Sport and Sport for People with a Disability was approved by the ASC board on November 30 2006. Subsequently the plan was then

sent to the Minister for the Arts and Sports for consideration by the Australian Government. We are now waiting on the 2007 Federal Budget to determine what the grants shall be.

I will not be standing for re-election for the position of the director Table Tennis New South Wales Disability Services. I take this opportunity to thank all who have supported and helped me since obtaining this position a few years ago. I am more than willing to assist the new director and continue to work for the good of disabled sport.
