- ANNUAL REPORT -

32nd Annual Report to be presented to Members at the Annual General Meeting to be held at Room 309, 3rd floor, Postal Institute, Ash Street, Sydney, on 21st March, 1968.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

This, the Thirty-second Annual Report covers the activities of your Association for the year 1967.

The year under review has not been an easy one and your Council has had to overcome many problems to ensure the success it has achieved.

Unfortunately most Members of the Association are only concerned with the playing side of Table Tennis and give little co-operation to Council. Members take it for granted that Competitions and Championships will be conducted, teams will be selected for Representative Matches, etc. but no thought is given to the planning and administration that is necessary to keep our Organisation running smoothly.

Another aspect that has caused serious concern to Council, is the apparent refusal of most Affiliated Associations to offer any co-operation at all. This has been most noticeable in the conduct of Country Championships, most of which were conducted without any prior reference to Council.

To effectively control Table Tennis in New South Wales your Council at all times needs the co-operation and support from all Members and all Affiliated Associations. It is hoped that in the coming year your Council will receive a full measure of support from all concerned.

FINANCE:

The start of the present year saw finances of the Association at a very low ebb.

With outstanding commitments of just under \$500, the incoming Council was faced with an unenviable task. Council has been able to meet these and other commitments and finish the year with a CREDIT BALANCE.

Special thanks in this regard are due to Cliff McDonald who conducted a '200 Club' which raised just on \$200 and to the Committee and Members of the N.S.W. Public Service Table Tennis Association, who are donating part of the proceeds of a 'Popular Girl' Competition to this Association. To date, funds received from this source amount to \$300.

The financial structure of this Association needs a complete overhaul to ensure financial stability. Fund raising activities must be increased, new avenues for revenue should be explored and economies effected where possible

Once again M. Wilcox and C. McDonald fought out the final of the Mens Open Singles with victory going to M. Wilcox. Old rivals T. Smith and J. Brown figured in the final of the Ladies Open Singles with T. Smith taking the honours.

OTHER CHAMPIONSHIPS

During the year the Association conducted a number of Championship events which included the City of Sydney, played at the Budapest Table Tennis Club, Lennox Street, Newtown; the Metropolitan and the Sydney Championships played at the N.S.W. Table Tennis Centre Pty Ltd.

COUNTRY WEEK

The Annual Country Week Championships was held at the N.S.W. Table Tennis Centre Pty Ltd. over the "long" Queen's Birthday week-end.

Teams and players from the following Country Centres participated in these events - Newcastle, Tamworth, Maitland, Illawarra, Dubbo, Nepean, Armidale and Australian Capital Territory.

A meeting of representatives was held during the Championships and resulted in the formation of the N.S.W. Country League.

The object of the League was the promotion of Table Tennis in Country Centres and the conduct of the Annual Country Week Championship.

COUNTRY TOUR OF VICTORIA

At the conclusion of the Country Week Championship, the following team was announced to tour Victorian Country Centres.

MICHAEL SZABADOS AWARD

The Michael Szabados Award for 1967 was made to Mr. K. Cole. Mr. Cole, who is 1st Vice-President of the Association and also a leading player, was awarded this honour in recognition of his outstanding services to Table Tennis, both as a player and an official.

During the past year Mr. Cole participated in all major Championship events, assisted Miss N. Callman in her management of the teams at the Australian National Championships and also assisted in the conduct of the various Championships held by the Association.

Council extends its congratulations to Mr. Cole and compliments him on the qualities for which the Award was made.

RESIGNATION

Miss N. Callinan, who for many years had held the position of Assistant Secretary of the Association, tendered her resignation on 14th December, 1967. The resignation was accepted with deep regret.

Miss Callinan who resigned for health reasons, has been one of the "STALWARTS" of the Association, and her loss as an Administrator and a helping hand is a serious blow to Table Tennis in N.S.W.

All Council Members and indeed, all associated with our sport, wish Norma a speedy recovery and trust that it will not be too long before her valuable experience is again available to the Association.

FINANCIAL

Appended hereto is the Treasurer's Financial Report and Balance Sheet. When assessing the financial result for the year under review, it is important to remember that much of the 1967 expenditure related to items which were incurred during the previous year and which the Association was unfortunately unable to meet. By arrangement with creditors, payment of these accounts was deferred until a more opportune time.

Items included in this category were Table Hire for Venner Coaching Tour (\$105), Victorian Country Mens Tour of N.S.W. (\$72), N.S.W. Ladies Tour of Victoria (\$40), Association Badges (\$40.88), Blazers (\$75) and other miscellaneous expenditure.

The fact that the Association has been able to meet these and other commitments; indicates not only a sound financial recovery, but also expert management of the financial resources available. This in itself could give rise to some complacency regarding future financial dealings, but this is not so; for despite considerable savings in Administrative costs, particularly in relation to Stores, Stationery, Postage and Printing costs, much more has to be done before finances can be classed as health.

Repayment in respect of monies not banked by a former Treasurer continue to be maintained and it appears that the Association may expect a full, if somewhat slow, compensation in this matter.

The major items of expenditure during the year were the arrears already mentioned, the Junior Championships held in Perth and the

Australian Championships played at Adelaide.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

The Association was engaged in a number of other activities during the year, which included the promotion of Table Tennis at the Willoughby Youth Centre, the Ampol Tournament conducted at the N.S.W. Table Tennis Centre Pty Ltd. and negotiations with Newcastle City Council regarding the inclusion of Table Tennis in the Commonwealth Games which that Council is desirous of securing for Newcastle.

Your Secretary was Guest Speaker at a Dinner given by Campsie Rotary Club at which he presented a film of the World Championship held in Peking.

The thanks of the Association are extended to the various persons, firms and organisations which assisted in so many ways during the past year.

Special thanks are extended to Mr. W. Robbins (Life Member) who acted as Official Recorder for all grades; to Mr. J. Lindsay and Mr. K. Cole for their work on the Championship Sub-Committee and to Mr. C. McDonald for his fund raising activities.

The All Nations Club, Kings Cross and the Australian Postal Institute (N.S.W. Division) are also thanked for providing meeting room facilities for the Association.

Worthy of special mention also, are the efforts of the three Popular Girl Candidates - Miss A. Reid (N.S.W.T.T.C. Pty Ltd), Miss D. Mansfield (N.S.W.T.T.A.) and Miss D. Hughton (N.S.W.P.S.T.T.A)

My personal thanks are extended to Miss N. Callinan, who so ably assisted me during the past year.
