PAUL PINKEWICH'S JOURNEY

Paul won the most NSW Open Men's Singles Titles a total of 11 times so far in 1971, 1972, 1973, 1974, 1977, 1979, 1980, 1982, 1986, 1997 and 2003 for more than 3 decades. Paul claimed 24 Australian Titles, 6 Oceania Titles, and 14 International Medals. Paul has officially represented Australia at 10 World Championships, 6 Oceania Events and numerous European and Commonwealth Championships over a 25 year period, and represented Australia in 287 International matches.
