In an endeavour to create competent umpires, the Australian Table Tennis Association is launching a scheme, whereby, candidates will be asked to sit for an examination on the Rules of Table Tennis. Successful candidates will be issued with an umpire's badge. The examination will be held early in 1953, and it is hoped that by this scheme, the standard of umpiring will be improved, and that a large number of players will avail themselves of the opportunity of taking the examination.

WORLD'S CHAMPIONSHIPS. 1954.

Plans are now being made for an Australian team to visit England in 1954, for the World's Championships. Early in 1953, a training squad will be formed, further players may be added during the year. As N.S.W. has many young promising players, the possibility of a trip to England should act as added incentive to them to improve their game.
