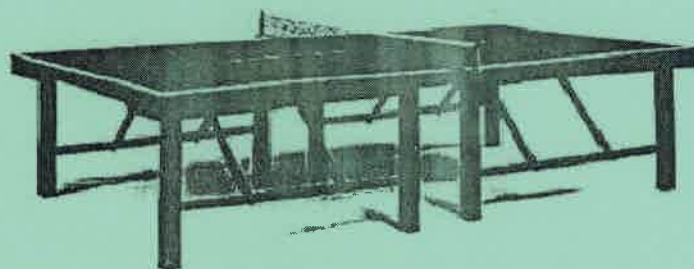

Secretary's Report– 2005

2005 was another very productive year for Table Tennis NSW.

We gained two new affiliated associations/clubs –

- Port Macquarie P.C.Y.C.
- South Tweed Sports Table Tennis Club

2005 was our 4th year at Sydney Olympic Park – Sports Halls and again in good partnership with the State Sports Centre Trust

We look forward to the continued day-time programmes with the local schools

The venue was open Tuesdays from 7pm to 9 pm for training & coaching – Paul Zhao the on duty coach. We also ran a Social two person teams competition which ran for 12 weeks

On Thursday nights the Metropolitan / Insurance Competition increased the number of teams once again - and it is encouraging to see more & more junior teams and players participating in one of the two grades. The competition also includes novice players & coaching. Congratulation to Les Walczuk for his continued organisation & success of this competition – this comp will re-commence on Thursday 16th February 2005.

The Veterans monthly pennant also had increased the number of teams participating – five grades with 32 teams – Again it was encouraging to see Junior Teams and Junior players gaining valuable teams match practice – U12 Boys team in the B1 Division and Junior Girls Team in the Ladies Division as well as some of the Top Junior Boys playing in the A1 Division – all very valuable experience , the results were evident especially in the Women's & Junior Girls Team's events at the National Championships – with the Junior Girls 1 x Gold & 2 Silver & Veterans 1 x Gold & 1 x bronze.

The City Vs Country annual challenge was again a very enjoyable & successful day with City this year being victorious

In 2005 NSW had the venue for two national championships run by Table Tennis Australia:

- 1) The Australian Open Championships held at the Olympic Park Sports Halls. This was the first Australian Open Championships since 1996 – We had thirteen men's teams nominate to play – the current regulation unfortunately only permits a maximum of Ten Teams. We also had a record nine teams in the Women's Teams Championship and it was good to have both a Men's & women's Team from New Zealand. The standard of play during the week was excellent producing some high quality and excitingly closes matches which were witnessed by large numbers of spectators both during the day and especially during ALL of the night matches. It was also encouraging to see the

improvement in the play of ALL the juniors who played in both teams and individuals. Overall a very successful Championship.

- 2) Australian Athletes with Disabilities Championships – this was the 3rd annual championships held at the Olympic Park Sports Halls and ran over three days – a very successful championships hosted by Table Tennis NSW –The championship followed the Australian Open Championship and many of the players were able to watch the Finals of the Australian Open on the Friday . Many thanks to the volunteers, officials, players and carers who ALL made these championships a success.

The 2005 Tournaments were encouraging with numbers up in most tournaments. with a few more organisational changes. The Tournaments for 2006 WILL run to a strict schedule on the closing dates – with no re-draws on the day, which, had contributed to delays with events commencing late, with the extra tables again being booked (the middle zone) for Junior & Veterans – Open & Closed Tournaments as well as the Metropolitan Open, this will allow up to 28 tables for singles round robin matches.

Once again the NSW Schools tournaments were also successful with the new Schools Tournament Director Ian Finlay having packed stadiums for most events. Ian was well assisted by Tien Quach. Tien organised an early closing date for each event which allowed draws to be timed and forwarded to each school in advance, this proved extremely successful.

Our representative teams for 2005 have once again had excellent performances.

The acceptance of late entries was causing a number of problems with numerous redraws having to be done during the tournaments. This was affecting my ability to actually run the tournaments and resulted in the tournament referees having to take a role in running the tournament which made it hard for them to do the job of actually refereeing the tournaments.

In 2006 no late entries will be accepted and the closing date will be earlier to ensure that entries reach me before the tournament is run. In 2005 at least three entries would turn up after every tournament had been run.

In conclusion I would like to thank Leonie Whiteford, Tien Quach and Ian Finlay for their invaluable assistance during the year.

We also hope to have an increased number of officials umpiring at events to assist players to become more familiar with the rules and help raise the level of professionalism in Table Tennis, which will in turn increase its profile and generate more pride and enjoyment in our great sport. Please give these officials your co-operation.

Although there were no training courses conducted last year, it is hoped to arrange an umpires seminar later in the year both to train new State Umpires and allow our current ones, who now have the required two years at State level, to upgrade to National level.

It is also hoped to run a course to train referees later in the year.

Disability Director's Report - 2005

There has been increased interest and support for the disabled table tennis players in NSW in the year 2004-05. This has been mainly in the formation of a Disability Committee and some funding which has commenced. It is our main objective to increase the number of disabled players to register with Table Tennis New South Wales.

OBJECTIVE:

- To have all existing registered as able players to become registered
- To find enough people to support groups of disabled people playing together on a regular basis
- A two-player team's competition will be held at Homebush on Tuesday nights. Two Singles each and one Doubles. Also coaching if required.

Championships will be held for AWD in conjunction with the State Open and Closed and other Championships to be negotiated.

Mental Health Table Tennis team's competition was conducted during the year for two Divisions. All the participating teams enjoyed the team competition which added a new dimension to the fun and pleasure. The teams will become a regular event.

The teams consisted of a division A & B - a consolation division conducted for the teams who did not win a team's match. Thanks to all the volunteers who helped out on the day.

The Singles Round Robin was conducted in A, B, C, D and Ladies. All events were played at the Addison Centre in Marrickville. Unfortunately, we do not have this centre for 2006 as rent has become far too expensive. Negotiations have begun with the PCYC Marrickville for 2006.

Thanks to Gillian Hutchinson for attending the Australian Sports Commission Disability Program conducted through NSW Sports and Recreation. This program aims to assist Table Tennis NSW to promote education and understanding of disability for both non-disabled and disabled alike.

In March, 2005, Luisa Silva and I attended Project Connect in Canberra in conjunction with Sports and Recreation and Australian Sports Commission. The aim of this project was for each governing body to develop strategies by each state for the following:

- Structure of incorporating disabled players into the system
- Education
- Membership
- Regions
- Funding requests and
- Plans for national implementation of these key elements

Australian Paralympics Committee established an Identification Project for Beijing Paralympics Games, with a targeted age group of 12 years and above, however, this is not exclusive. Table Tennis NSW was given very little notice and I feel we need better communication with Paralympics Committee and Table Tennis Australia Disabilities Director. Thanks to Alan Taylor for helping me on the day and transporting equipment to Strathfield University.

A multi-school Sports Day is to be held at Blacktown Olympic Park for children with disabilities. Five sports have been chosen with table tennis as one. Gillian Hutchinson and I will be in attendance and plans are well on the way for a great day.

The first Table Tennis Championships was held at Marsden Road Public School, Liverpool. There was a Division 1 and 2. These children with disabilities are now playing and enjoying the game at a very good standard, playing some excellent shots and are able to rally well.

Joy Boyd has been selected to represent Australia at the Commonwealth Games in Melbourne on 2006. NSW wishes her all the best. Joy also travelled to Korea in 2005 and was successful in winning a medal. Congratulations Joy!

Many thanks to all the volunteers throughout 2005, also Lyn Phillips and Margot Zaska from NSW Sports and Recreation for all their help as, without volunteers, we could not have achieved what has been a very successful year. I look forward to your support in 2006.

Thanks also to DJ's Trophies for their continued support as they again, in 2005, engraved all trophies for athletes with a disability, free of charge. This is their second year of this support.
