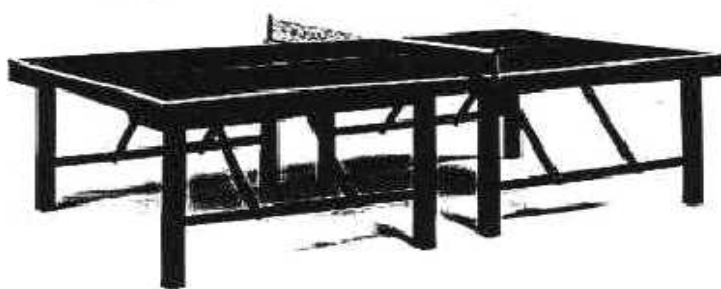

PRESIDENT'S REPORT FOR 2014

It is my pleasure to present my first President's Report for Table Tennis NSW.

As many of you may be aware I was a reluctant nomination for this position following the decision by our former President, Dennis O'Brien, to stand down after five years in the role.

Table tennis in NSW owes Dennis a huge debt of gratitude for his efforts over those five years which have seen a significant growth in our membership and our communications with our Affiliated Associations.

He had overseen a growth of over 50% in the number of Affiliated Associations in NSW and a further increase of over 100% in our membership numbers. The challenge to us now is to build on this framework he put in place.

There have been a number of highlights occurring in 2014 which I believe should be advised to our members.

Firstly, I am delighted to advise that the Central Coast Table Tennis Association celebrated sixty (60) years of operation in 2014 and Table Tennis Western Sydney celebrated fifty (50) years of providing organised competition in the Western Suburbs of Sydney. Both Affiliates should be congratulated for their efforts over those periods and we look forward to working with you to ensure your continued success.

Secondly, the Country Championships continue to expand with 54 teams competing in the Championships at Niagara Park. These Championships are a graded teams event, which have been hailed by the majority of those participating as a most enjoyable, well-run competition. I commend the competition to all country players. Mark the 2015 date in your diary.

The St George and Sutherland Shire Association should also be congratulated for their efforts in organising one of the most well run Australian Junior Championships in 2014. They were only given the green light to run the Championships four months before the date and they were run like clockwork. There were many innovations at the Championships which should be used in any future efforts. These efforts were recognised in the Australian Parliament where the local member devoted a significant amount of time to the Championships in a speech to the members.

In 2014 we welcomed a new Affiliate from Grafton Table Tennis Club. Efforts had been made in the past to revive our sport in the town and have until now been unsuccessful. If any members are able to assist the club in its formative years it would be appreciated. In particular, if you have any friends or relatives living in that area please encourage them to try our sport.

In 2014 we took the step of appointing a Development Officer to assist in the promotion of our sport. The economics of the role have meant that it is currently working mainly in the Sydney metropolitan area however we must consider ways in which this may be expanded state wide in 2015. The Development Officer, Richard Lassen, has been working successfully in a number of areas including

1. Working with the PCYC organisation to expand our membership
2. Working with the Schools network to increase participation in table tennis in schools
3. Contacting a large number of our Affiliated Associations to discuss ways in which Table Tennis NSW may assist them in the running of our game.

4. Restructuring of our website to make it more user friendly. If you haven't visited the site I suggest you do so as it is much more interactive.

We ran two Level 1 Coaching Courses at Penrith and the Port Macquarie Table Tennis Club also ran a very successful course in November. I am of the firm opinion that if we wish our sport to progress we need to have as many coaches as possible and these courses are a major stepping stone to achieving this position. Incidentally the NSW Government has passed legislation for all people in NSW who are working with children. At the most recent Council Meeting it was agreed that ALL our coaches MUST provide the appropriate confirmation to TTNSW that they have completed the Working with Children requirements.

On a negative note I was extremely disappointed to see the number of players who, for a variety of reasons, made themselves unavailable for selection to the NSW teams attending the National Championships in Perth.

We will be looking at tightening the requirements to represent NSW in the future to ensure this does not occur again. Our qualification requirements are not onerous and only require our members to play in a small number of tournaments to gain selection. We do allow exemptions under specific circumstances but this has been abused.

Table Tennis NSW must sign off on the entry of any NSW player wishing to play in the Championships and, from there, gain selection to represent Australia. I would like to ensure that this sign off is not given unless the specific rules are adhered to.

Finally, I thank you for your assistance to me personally in 2014 and wish you and your members a successful 2015

AWD REPORT FOR 2014

The development of AWD table tennis in NSW has grown steadily in the past 3 years.

In 2014, there were 3 clubs actively providing weekly coaching sessions for players with a disability (Fairfield/Cabramatta PCYC, Nam Ho Academy and Port Macquarie Table Tennis Club).

At the 2014 Australian AWD Table Tennis Championships which was held in the Gold Coast, we had 11 players representing NSW (4 wheelchair players and 7 standing players). Mark Harris, a class 3 wheelchair player, was the most outstanding player. He won Gold in all wheelchair events, including Men Open Wheelchair Singles, Men Wheelchair Doubles, Class 2-4 Singles and Wheelchair Teams.

Mark Harris is currently the only NSW player selected on the Australian Para Squad. As a squad member, Mark had the opportunity to represent Australia in international events including, the 2013 ITTF PTT Oceania Regional Trial, the 2014 Thai Para Open and the 2014 World Para Championships in China.

Looking ahead for 2015, we will have at least 13 participants registered with NSW Table Tennis (3 in the wheelchair category and 10 in the standing category).

More importantly from a development point of view, we now have 2 junior players, Sasha Dansereau and Gemma Hockley. They have been training the past 12 months, preparing to represent NSW for the first time at the 2015 Australian AWD Table Tennis Championships in Hobart.

In conclusion, AWD table tennis in NSW has a bright future in the years to come.

We have to thank our recorders, Syd Birchall, Clement Siu, Owen Ow, Sonny Ching and Allan Xu, the latter also for keeping the website up to date, for their dedication to bring us the results so speedy and accurate.

ST GEORGE AND SUTHERLAND SHIRE TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION

2014 PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The St George and Sutherland Shire Table Tennis Association is exceptionally proud to report that 2014 was its most successful year ever. Membership numbers continued to grow, with 161 members registered in 2014. In addition, the quality of players competing and the standard of play continued to improve remarkably.

Tuesday Night Pennant

Competition takes place every Tuesday night at the Hurstville Aquatic and Leisure Centre on King Georges Road, Hurstville. There were three competitions held during the year, being Summer, Winter and Spring Pennants, over 14 weeks each. As it has been for the last 7 years, teams comprised 2 players a night; playing a Davis Cup format of 2 singles (best of 7 games) each player and one doubles (best of 5 games), a total of 5 matches.

There were 32 teams playing in 5 grades in the Summer Pennant, 34 teams in 5 grades in the Winter Pennant and 37 teams in 5 grades in the Spring Pennant. One of the most encouraging developments during the year was the increasing number of spectators attending the Tuesday night competition. It provided an electric atmosphere with people clapping and cheering throughout and it brought out the best in our players.

Due to the increasing number of players and teams and to move towards the future, a new format is being introduced in 2015. The top 2 grades will now comprise 8 3-person teams playing 8 matches a night (all best of 5 games). Each player plays 2 singles matches (a total of 6) and there will be 2 doubles matches. The pennant will run over 14 weeks (playing each team twice) with the winner being first-past-the-post. The lower grades will continue with the same format as last year.

2014 Australian Junior Table Tennis Championships

The most exciting event to take place during the year for the Association our hosting the 2014 Australian Junior Table Tennis Championships in September-October. Early in 2014, unfortunate circumstances lead to the Championships being without a venue for 2014. The Association expressed interest in hosting the event, submitted an application and much to our surprise, we were granted the rights to host the event. Normally, an Association has 1-2 years to organize such an event but with only 4 months to go, there was a lot to do in a short time. Our Association is lucky to have a large group of dedicated and skilled people it can draw upon, people who were willing to take up such a challenge.

A Sub-committee was formed and began organizing immediately in a very professional manner. The members of the Sub-committee were Graham Boyton, Stephen Bruton, Connie Chan, Steve Eggleton, Stephen Gillespie, Marie Pinkewich, Anita Un and Leonie Whiteford. Members of the associated Organising Committee were Douglas Flood, Phil Males and Ian Finlay. 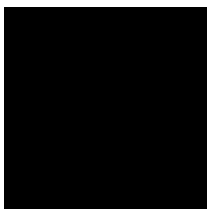

Participation in the monthly Vets Challenge competition was well supported across all 4 grades. We had over 200 regular players, with 10 teams in both A1 and A2, 8 teams in B1 and 6 in B2. Special thanks again to Ian Finlay who so ably runs this competition and to Jennifer Aduckiewicz, Beverley Clackson and Gillian Hutchinson who are the Grade Coordinators. Although many teams have 6 or 7 players and Grade Coordinators work hard to fill all teams, there were still a few forfeits. Next year we are proposing to introduce new measures to assist captains fill their teams prior to the day's event.

- a) The introduction of a Captains Cup in honour of the Beaumont Family. The award aims to encourage captains to better organise their teams, ensure good communication with team members, equitable distribution of games and to reward excellent captainship. Players must nominate their team captain for the award. The winning captain, as determined by the Veterans Committee will receive the Captain's Cup and a free dinner at the Veterans Christmas Party.
- b) A one page flyer will be distributed to all captains outlining their responsibilities.

We are grateful to NSWTTA which runs the NSW Veterans Open and Closed Championships each year. The tournaments were well run on the day but the Veterans Committee has alerted NSWTTA of our concerns regarding the draw process. Thanks to the members of the NSW Veteran Selectors' Committee who poured over the results to seed players for these tournaments and then select the NSW National Veterans Table Tennis Team and to determine 2014 rankings. We are grateful to Paul Pinkewich of [tabletennisworld](http://tabletennisworld.com) for his continuing sponsorship and to Joy Boyd for purchasing a range of gift prizes which were much appreciated by all players.

Throughout the year we try to build closer ties with our regional players. A small contingent represented NSW at the East Coast Invitational in March, we sadly lost the City vs Country Shield at Niagara Park in September and many went to Blayney in November for an enjoyable full day's play in the Central West Round Robin. May I encourage you to join us this year to support NSW Veterans Table Tennis across the regions.
